The extended range of services now includes 24-hour room service, a turn-down service, parking service, and a guest relations team.

The Parkhotel continues to focus on partners in the region when working with service providers: for example, the fashion manufacturer Seidensticker from Bielefeld offers a last-minute shirt service, and the Bielefeld-based company Hunter offers an exclusive dog treatment. In addition, regional producers are given priority when purchasing food.
